Lymphedema Treatment Act 2025: Coverage, Compliance, and Clinical Impact for Wound Care Nurses

Description

The Lymphedema Treatment Act (LTA) represents the first major expansion of Medicare coverage for compression therapy in decades. Effective January 1, 2024, the Act created a new DMEPOS benefit category for medically necessary lymphedema compression treatment items—a transformative step for patients with both primary and secondary lymphedema, including those with chronic venous ulcers.

This session translates legislative policy into bedside practice. Participants will learn what the law covers, how to document for coverage, and how to protect themselves and their organizations through audit-ready compliance and interdisciplinary coordination.

- **Review** the key provisions and effective components of the Lymphedema Treatment Act (2024) and their implications for wound care practice.
- **Discuss** the documentation and diagnostic coding requirements that support Medicare coverage for lymphedema compression treatment items.
